











Spaces for events


Up to 100 people standing in the urban garden.


















Spaces

Fifth Floor | Terrace








The Collection includes masterpieces of paintings and Italian sculpture of the interwar period by Giacomo Balla, Mario Sironi, Giorgio De Chirico, Antonio Donghi, Mario Mafai, Antonietta Raphaël, Giuseppe Capogross and others.
